Kaivac Awarded Patent

Hamilton, OH – June 2, 2010 - The [U.S. Patent and Trademark Office](#) has awarded a patent to [Kaivac, Inc.](#), for its [QuickDraw System](#).

This instant chemical-injection system is specifically designed to allow users in smaller facilities to take advantage of Kaivac's popular [No-Touch Cleaning[®] System](#).

Using the systems multimode spray gun, users can apply cleaning agents to surfaces and then rinse those areas clean in a much more precise and targeted manner.
