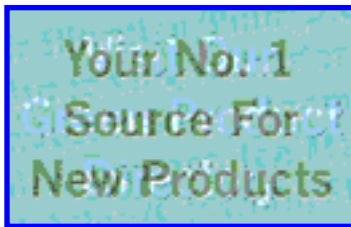

Waterless Donates Urinals to Leading Drug Treatment Center

VISTA, CALIF.—Triangle Residential Options for Substance Abusers, Inc. (TROSА), Durham, N.C.—one of the nation’s leading and most respected residential, re-educational centers helping men, women, and young adults with substance abuse problems—will be receiving waterless urinal systems donated by Waterless Co, LLC, for a new facility the organization is building.

TROSА, which treats people free of charge, has been recognized as a leader in drug treatment therapies by Duke University and the Public Broadcasting Service and is a finalist in the Ford Foundation’s Leadership for a Changing World award. 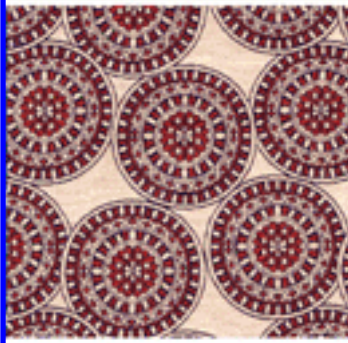
